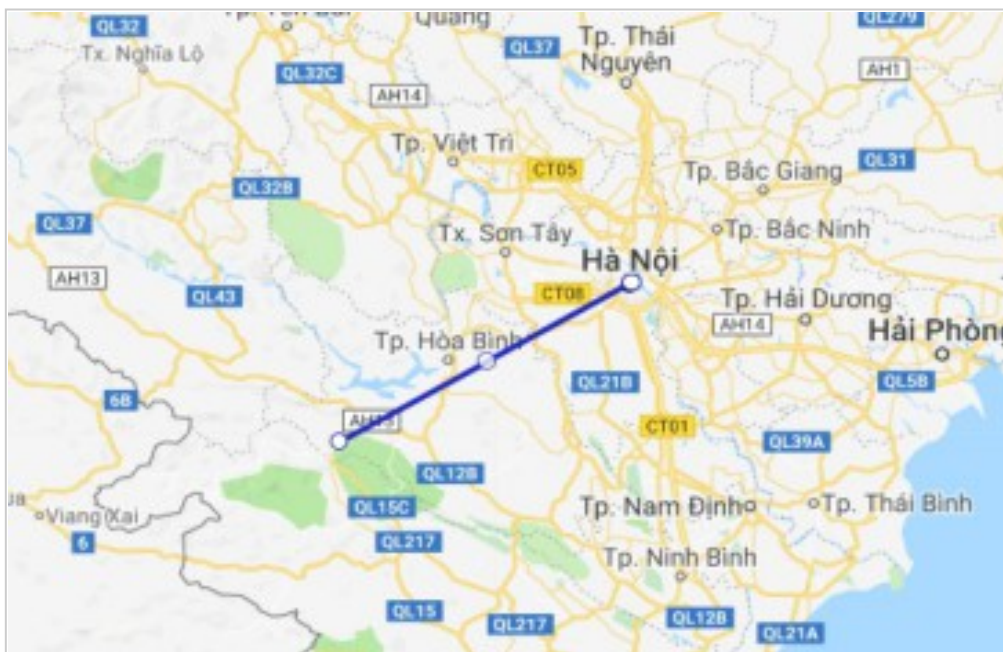

## Cancellation by Customer

- More than 30 days before arrival: No charge

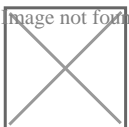

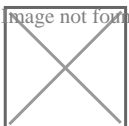
